Eligibility Guidelines

- The applicant must be a private tax-exempt organization under Sections 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code. Schools, municipalities, political, lobbying and religious organizations are ineligible.
- The applying organization must be established as a nonprofit for at least one year and cannot be seeking to dissolve or merge with another agency.
- The organization's board of directors must have a minimum of six members who are representative of the community. The majority of the board can neither be employees nor employees' relatives.
- Organization located in our 21-town service area and serve residents of these towns are eligible: Beacon Falls, Bethlehem, Bridgewater, Cheshire, Goshen, Litchfield, Middlebury, Morris, Naugatuck, New Milford, Oxford, Prospect, Roxbury, Southbury, Thomaston, Warren, Washington, Waterbury, Watertown, Wolcott or Woodbury.

2. Give a brief history of your organization. (Year founded, major accomplishments, etc.)

5. Describe your board of directors (number of directors, committees).
