**Unless otherwise noted:** All scholarships are for students residing in the [Foundation's 21-town area](#), require a B- (2.75) minimum cumulative grade point average, and are available to first-time, current, or returning college students.

Scholarship	Scholarship Criteria
<b>(Post University) Malcolm Baldrige School of Business Scholarship **</b>	One-time award for entering first-year <u>or</u> transfer students pursuing a full-time undergraduate degree offered through the Malcolm Baldrige School of Business at Post University's main campus in Waterbury, CT: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant does not need to reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area</li> <li>• Applicant must submit essay on how an organization can benefit from emphasis on quality</li> <li>• Applicant must provide two letters of support from teacher, guidance counselor, or community leader having direct interaction with student</li> </ul>
<b>Sergeant Felix M. DelGreco, Jr. Scholarship</b> <i>(\$4,000 award)</i>	For students who are a son/daughter of a current member of the CT Army National Guard: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant does not need to reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area</li> <li>• Applicant must be attending an accredited college degree or technical program</li> <li>• Additional reference letter required, which must specifically address character traits</li> <li>• Award is merit-based (financial need is not considered)</li> </ul>
<b>Harris Family Schl.</b>	For area students pursuing a post-secondary degree in an agriculture-related field
<b>H. D. Segur and Friends Scholarship *</b>	One-time award for graduating high-school students entering college: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One recommendation letter must be provided by a client of HD Segur</li> <li>• Applicant may reside anywhere in Connecticut</li> <li>• Award is merit-based (financial need is not considered)</li> </ul>
<b>Hubbard Hall Scholarship</b>	"To support post-secondary school studies for children or step-children of employees of Hubbard-Hall Inc. for up to four years. Applicants do not need to reside in the Foundation's service area and will not be disqualified based on financial need. <i>(Eligibility for future scholarship aid is not dependent upon continued/current employment at Hubbard Hall.)</i> "
<b>Middlebury Lions Club Scholarship *</b>	One-time award for graduating high-school residents of Middlebury demonstrating above-average community service
<b>Carl J. Niedzial Memorial Scholarship</b>	For members of CT State Police Credit Union or immediate family (including grandchildren) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant does not need to reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area</li> </ul>
<b>Persbacker Family Fund Scholarship</b> <i>(\$2,500+ award)</i>	For residents of Bridgewater (6+ years) who have been involved in significant volunteer community service in the town of Bridgewater: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must provide two letters from non-school individuals attesting to community service</li> <li>• Essay must specifically address community service</li> </ul>
<b>Pride in the Hills Scholarship *</b>	One-time award for graduating high school students who identify as LGBTQ+ or as active allies of the LGBTQ+ community: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant must provide extra essay setting forth reasons they should receive the award</li> <li>• Allies of LGBTQ+ community must identify ways in which they have actively supported, celebrated, or improved the lives of their LGBTQ+ classmates or community members</li> </ul>
<b>Barbara and Frank Quadrato Veterinary Scholarship</b>	For students pursuing studies in veterinary medicine, with preference to students residing in Woodbury or Bethlehem
<b>Roxbury Volunteer Fire Department Memorial Scholarship</b> <i>(\$2,000+, one award only)</i>	For entering or current college students residing in Roxbury, pursuing a post-secondary education at a two or four year junior college, college, technical school, or other institution offering post-graduate study/training; preference is given to current/former members (or junior corps members) of Roxbury Fire Department (or direct descendants)
<b>Dr. and Mrs. Arthur F. Sullivan Scholarship</b>	For students entering or currently enrolled in an accredited medical (e.g. graduate) school: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant must show exemplary academic achievement</li> <li>• NOTE: This fund is only available in <u>even</u> years (e.g. 2026/2028/2030)</li> </ul>

\* One-time award, available to graduating high school seniors only

\*\* One-time award, available to students of any age
