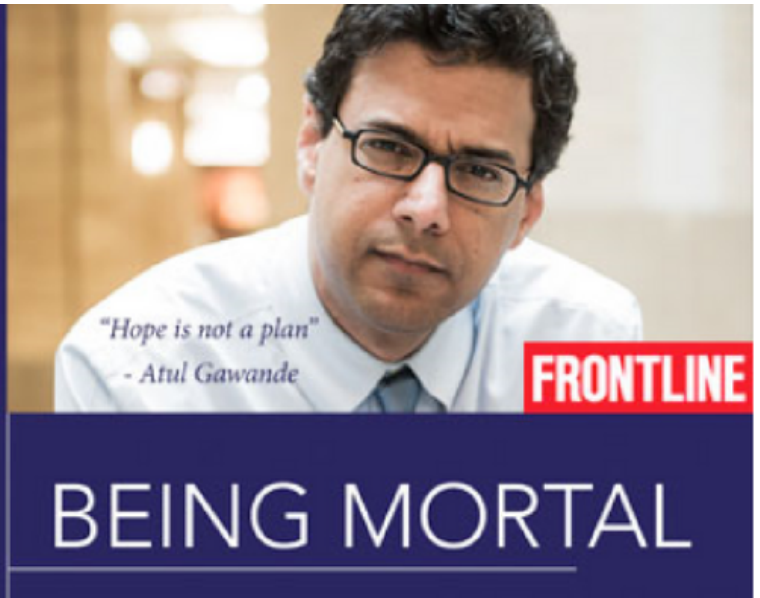


**If you thought you were dying,
