



### Special Scholarship Worksheet (2019)

Please use this worksheet as a reference before completing our online *special* scholarship application. If you meet **all criteria** for any one of the scholarships listed below, check it off on this list, and then check it off on the online application. **Unless otherwise noted:** All scholarships are for students residing in the [Foundation's 21-town area](#), require a B-minimum cumulative grade point average, and are available to first-time, current, or returning college students.

Scholarship	Scholarship Criteria
<b>(Post University) Malcolm Baldrige School of Business Scholarship</b> <i>(one-time award of \$1,000 or more)</i>	For entering first-year <u>or</u> transfer students pursuing a full-time undergraduate degree offered through the School of Business at Post University's main campus in Waterbury, CT: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant does not need to reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area.</li> <li>• Applicant must have high school or college (whichever is most recent) GPA of at least 2.75</li> <li>• Applicant must submit a 500 word essay on how an organization can benefit from emphasis on quality throughout its operations</li> <li>• Applicant must provide two letters from teacher, guidance counselor, or community leader having direct interaction with student</li> </ul>
<b>Sergeant Felix M. DelGreco, Jr. Scholarship</b> <i>(\$4,000 award)</i>	For students who are a son/daughter of a current member of the CT Army National Guard: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant does not need to reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area.</li> <li>• Applicant must be attending an accredited college degree or technical program</li> <li>• Additional reference letter required, which must specifically address character traits</li> <li>• Merit-based: Financial information not required for this fund</li> </ul>
<b>Harris Family Scholarship</b>	For students that reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area and intend to pursue (or are pursuing) a post-secondary degree in an agriculture-related field
<b>H. D. Segur and Friends Schl.</b> <i>(one-time award)</i>	Merit-based award for entering college freshmen recommended by any HD Segur client: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant may reside anywhere in Connecticut.</li> </ul>
<b>Middlebury Lions Club Schl.</b> <i>(one-time award)</i>	For graduating residents of Middlebury demonstrating above-average involvement in community service
<b>Lois Livingston McMillen Memorial</b>	For women actively pursuing (or who would like to pursue) an artistic career, with preference to artists in the visual arts of painting and design: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant must be attending accredited college or a qualified artist-in-residence program</li> </ul>
<b>Naomi Mildred Nicoll Scholarship</b>	For daughters of single <sup>1</sup> , working mothers, who cannot otherwise afford college: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant must live in Litchfield, Warren, Morris or Goshen</li> <li>• Applicant must be a graduate of Litchfield or Wamogo High School</li> </ul>
<b>Carl J. Niedzial Memorial Scholarship</b>	For members of CT State Police Credit Union or immediate family (including grandchildren) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant does not need to reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area.</li> </ul>
<b>Persbacker Family Fund Scholarship</b> <i>(\$2,500+)</i>	For residents of Bridgewater (6+ years) who have been involved in significant volunteer community service in the town of Bridgewater: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant must provide two letters from non-school individuals attesting to community service, and applicant's essay must specifically address community service</li> </ul>
<b>Roxbury Volunteer Fire Department Memorial Scholarship</b> <i>(\$2,000+, one award only)</i>	For entering or current college students residing in Roxbury, pursuing a post-secondary education at a two or four year junior college, college, technical school, or other institution offering post-graduate study/training. Preference is given to current/former members (or junior corps members) of Roxbury Fire Department (or direct descendants).
<b>Dr. and Mrs. Arthur F. Sullivan Scholarship</b>	For students entering or currently enrolled in an accredited medical school: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant must show exemplary academic achievement</li> <li>• NOTE: This fund is only available in <u>even</u> years (e.g. 2018/2020/2022)</li> </ul>
