Unless otherwise noted: All scholarships are for students residing in the [Foundation's 21-town area](#), require a B- (2.7) minimum cumulative grade point average, and are available to first-time, current, or returning college students.

| Scholarship | Scholarship Criteria |

| Sergeant Felix M. DelGreco, Jr. Scholarship ** | <p>One-time award for children of current members of CT Army National Guard (at time of application), enrolled in undergraduate degree program at accredited college/ university:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant is not required to reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area • Two recommendation letters are required: one from HS guidance counselor and/or college faculty advisor, and one providing information regarding the applicant's character traits. |
| Harris Family Scholarship | For area students pursuing a post-secondary degree in an agriculture-related field |
| H. D. Segur and Friends Scholarship * | <p>One-time award for graduating high-school students entering college:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One recommendation letter must be provided by a client of HD Segur • Applicant may reside anywhere in Connecticut • Award is merit-based (financial need is not considered) |
| Hubbard Hall Scholarship | <p>To support post-secondary school studies for children or step-children of employees of Hubbard-Hall Inc. Applicants do not need to reside in CCF's service area and will not be disqualified based on financial need. Recipients may apply for and may receive a scholarship for up to four years of undergraduate study but annual process is competitive. <i>(NOTE: Eligibility for future aid is not dependent upon continued employment at Hubbard Hall.)</i></p> |
| Carl J. Niedzial Memorial Scholarship | <p>For members of CT State Police Credit Union or immediate family (including grandchildren)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant does not need to reside in the Foundation's 21-town service area |
| Persbacher Family Fund Scholarship (\$2,500+ award) | <p>For residents of Bridgewater (6+ years) who have been involved in significant volunteer community service in the town of Bridgewater:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must provide two letters from non-school individuals attesting to community service • Essay must specifically address community service |
| Pride in the Hills Scholarship * | <p>One-time award for graduating high school students who identify as LGBTQ+ or as active allies of the LGBTQ+ community:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant must provide extra essay setting forth reasons they should receive the award • Allies of LGBTQ+ community must identify ways in which they have actively supported, celebrated, or improved the lives of their LGBTQ+ classmates or community members |
| Roxbury Volunteer Fire Department Memorial Scholarship (\$2,000+, one award only) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For entering or current college students residing in Roxbury, pursuing a post-secondary education at a two or four-year junior college, college, technical school, or other institution offering post-graduate study/training. • Preference is given to current/former members (or junior corps members) of Roxbury Fire Department (or direct descendants) |
| Dr. and Mrs. Arthur F. Sullivan Scholarship | <p>For students entering or currently enrolled in an accredited medical (e.g. graduate) school:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant must show exemplary academic achievement • NOTE: This fund is only available in <u>even</u> years (e.g. 2026/2028/2030) |
